The authors of this chapter differentiate and outline the main phases in the development of Bulgarian historiography on the Balkan Wars within a period of almost 100 years. Generally speaking, these phases are predetermined by various factors, among the most important of which are those closely connected to the very development of the Bulgarian state.
